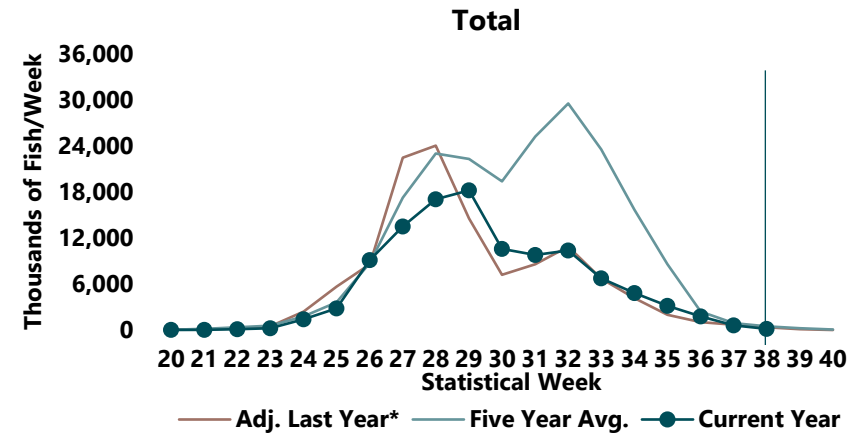
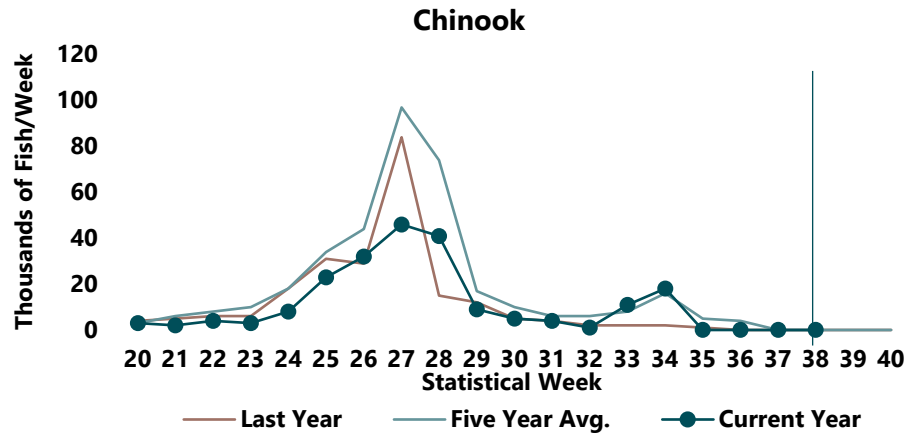
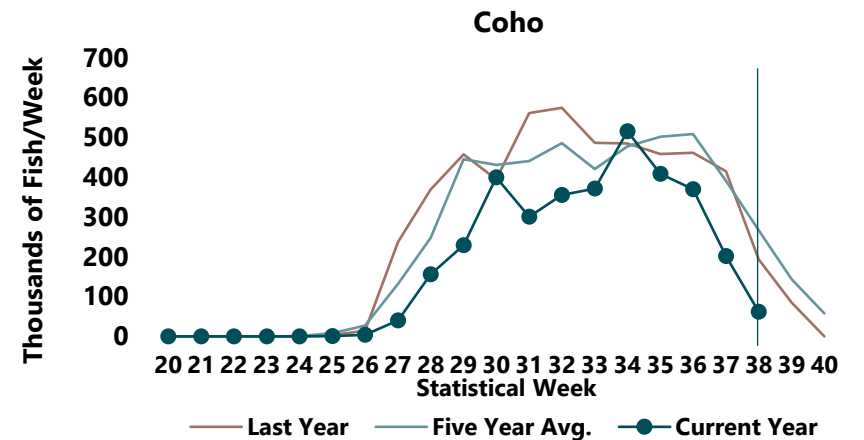
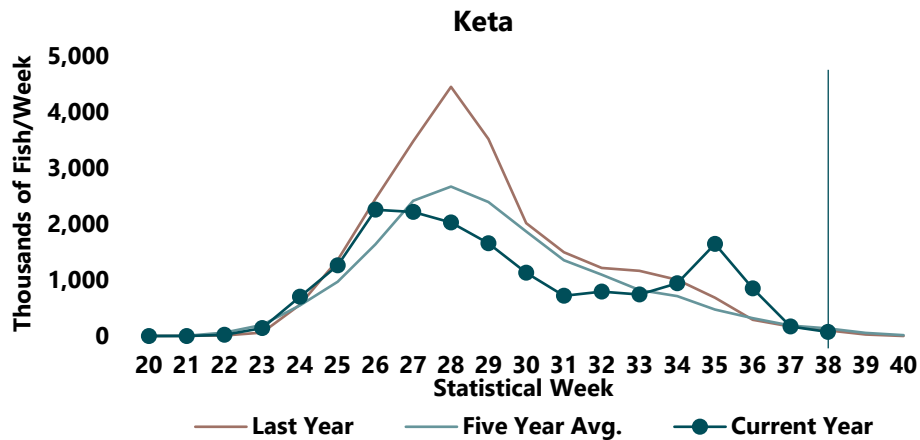
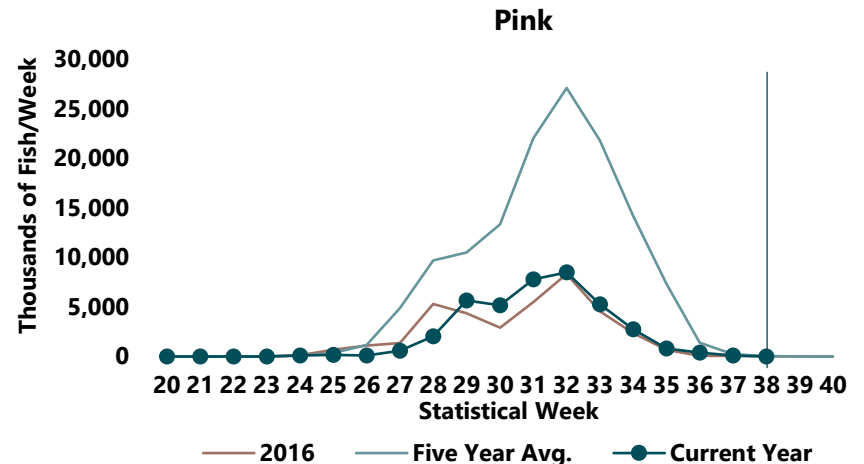
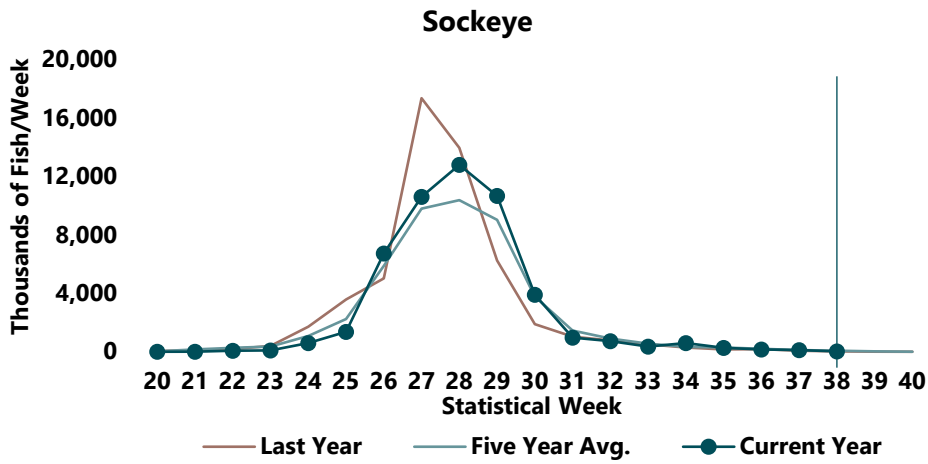
Slightly more than 150,000 salmon were harvested in Alaska last week, including about 70,000 keta, 60,000 coho, and 20,000 sockeye.

- YTD harvest of about 17.4 million keta is 28 percent lower than 2017's pace and similar to the 5-year average.
- Coho harvest of about 3.4 million fish is a third lower than 2017 and 29 percent below the 5-year average. One or two weeks of fishing remain.
- Few additional sockeye are expected in 2018. ADF&G's preliminary harvest summary for Bristol Bay described this year's harvest as the largest on record, measured by value and size of the return.
- Minimal pink or Chinook salmon were harvested in Alaska last week.
